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This month

In March 2024, the world of investments saw some positive performance, especially in the global stock market. There was a noticeable shift with investors moving away from high-growth technology companies.

Central banks remained cautious; they aren't in a rush to further increase interest rates. This decision is due to persistent concerns regarding inflation. Additionally, despite these concerns, the US economy has continued to be strong.

The US Federal Reserve left interest rates unchanged at their March meeting, with investors now broadly expecting a rate cut in June. However, the economic data shows that the US economy continues to add jobs while inflation remains high, which limits the possibility of rate cuts happening.

In Japan, their stock market reached an all-time high for the first time since 1989. Additionally, the Bank of Japan, which serves a similar role to the Federal Reserve in the US, decided to increase interest rates, showing they're confident in their financial markets.

Carbon Intensity¹

The equities in the low risk **SIMPS Portfolio** are **44% IESS** carbon intensive than the MSCI ACWI benchmark.

Businesses with lower carbon intensity demonstrate their operational efficiency and release less carbon into the atmosphere per pound of revenue.

Carbon Saved¹

Healthcare

Across all equity fund holdings² in the low risk SIMPS Portfolio, **19** companies provide access to healthcare.

7 report on the number of people who received access to healthcare.

In total, these 7 companies have provided healthcare to **81,636,260** people this reporting year³.

That's the equivalent of **0.6** person for each £100,000 invested in the low risk SIMPS Portfolio for 12 months.



Financial services

Across all equity fund holdings² in the low risk SIMPS Portfolio, 8 companies provide financial services.

5 report on the provision of financial services to those previously excluded.

In total, these 5 companies have provided financial services to **982,531,228** £100,000 invested in the people who previously didn't low risk SIMPS Portfolio have access to financial services this reporting year³.

That's the equivalent of **1.3** people for each for 12 months.



Renewable energy

Across all equity fund holdings² in the low risk SIMPS Portfolio, all **212** companies could produce their own renewable energy by investing in on-site renewable energy infrastructure.

47 companies report on renewable energy generation.

In total, these 47 companies have generated **31,371,716** MWh of renewable energy this reporting year³.

That's the equivalent of **0.4** MWh of renewable energy for each £100,000 invested in the low risk SIMPS Portfolio for 12 months.



Tribe IMPACT

Net jobs created

Across all equity fund holdings² in the low risk **SIMPS Portfolio**, all **212** companies can create new jobs, as well as terminate existing jobs. **187** companies report on jobs created and terminated (as a net job equivalency). In total, these 187 companies generated **388,656** net jobs in this reporting year³.

That's the equivalent of **0.0031** net jobs created for each £100,000 invested in the low risk **SIMPS Portfolio** for 12 months.



Waste recycled

Across the equity fund holdings² in the low risk **SIMPS Portfolio**, all **212** companies can recycle part or all of their waste. **82** companies report on waste recycled.

In total, these 82 companies have recycled **10,971,631** tonnes of waste this reporting year³. That's the equivalent of **119** kg of waste recycled for each £100,000 invested in the low risk **SIMPS Portfolio** for 12 months.

Gender

Multiple studies show that gender parity in business is essential in driving sustainable growth. Across the equity holdings² in the low risk **SIMPS Portfolio** there are **212** companies. Out of 212 companies, the average percentage of female board members is **35%**³.
